

SATOP CONSUMER RIGHTS

I have been given a copy of my SATOP Offender Assignment A-3 form, which indicates the SATOP program level, which I must complete;

_____ I have been given information to my right to a “second opinion” and to a “Judicial Review” of my SATOP referral;

_____ If referred to WIP, CIP, or SROP (Level IV), I have been given materials and instructions relative to Missouri’s Standard Means Test;

_____ I have been told that the assessment screening shall be valid for six months from the date of the initial screening. If I do not enroll into a SATOP or comparable program within these six months, it will be necessary for me to repeat the assessment screening process and pay a second OMU service fee (\$126.00) (but no additional \$249 supplemental fee);

_____ I have been told that should I give false information, or attempt subterfuge, this SATOP experience will be voided, and I may not be eligible for state financial support for future SATOP requirements which stem from my current DWI offense; and

_____ I have been told that if I receive another DWI after the assessment screening but before completion of the SATOP program, it will be necessary for me to repeat the assessment screening process, pay an additional OMU service fee (\$126) and \$249 supplemental fee, and complete another SATOP program.

CRITERIA FOR SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF SATOP PROGRAM

Successful completion requires that the SATOP consumer must:

- A. Be free of the influence of mood-altering substances at every session;
- B. Attend all sessions on time or contact the agency within 24 hours after the session;
- C. Attend sessions in their proper sequence unless approval for an alternate sequence is obtained;
- D. Complete all assignments and cooperatively participate in all activities;
- E. Pay all fees; and
- F. Complete and sign all required forms.
